

## PrintShop Mail - Win 5.0 Layout Properties



PrintShop Mail (PSM) allows for the use of mixed page sizes and orientation in a single job. Mixed-plex (simplex/duplex) options are also available.

**Properties Panel** Name: Allows the naming of the layout

Layout Properties: Layout Size: Selection of template size

Page Size: Selection of the output page size

Paper Tray: Tray selection

Action: Expression formula window

Number of Copies: Can be used to print multiple copies based on database field number values

Setup job for a specific printer: File > Page setup > Printer > select printer > OK > OK.

## How do I create a multi-page template?

Job with multi-page PDF: File > New > Blank document > Insert > PDF. (PSM automatically adjusts to the PDF's properties)

Job with single page EPS/PDF templates: File > New > Blank document > Layout > Size > select size > OK.

Add additional template pages: Layout > Insert.

Insert single page template: Highlight Layout# in the Properties Panel: Items window.

**Insert > PDF** (for PDF) or **Insert > Static Image** (for EPS).

How does mixed-plex work?

Each layout in the job will need to be setup one time for the simplex/duplex option.

## Adjust for simplex/duplex settings:


- 1) Highlight a Layout# in the Properties Panel: Items window.
- 2) **File > Page setup > Printer >** select printer > **Properties**.
- 3) Printer **Document Properties** window will show duplex options (flip on long edge, etc). Select an option (based on PPD) > **OK** > **OK** > **OK**.

*If the options are not there*, select **Advanced > Advanced Option:** 

**Duplex** or **Print Method** to get to the duplex options.

Select option > OK > OK > OK > OK.

Repeat this process for each Layout#.



## Assign the same layout settings for multiple layouts:

Multiple layouts can be selected by holding the Ctrl or Shift keys and "clicking" the left mouse button.
